Junior age group:

A junior is someone who is in 2020 year not older than 18 years (birth in 2002 and younger).

Awards:

The first three competitors in a category receive a medal, cup and a diploma. Other participants also receive a diplomas.

Rules of registration:

The competition is open to everyone from the World. Only passport of model compliant with Naviga rules is needed. Applications from national federations, clubs and individual competitors are accepted. In registration mail please write:

Registration of models will takes place on the 12th of June 2020 from 10am to late evening in office on place of competitions.
